

Kouts Lions Club—Dinner Meeting, August 4, 2011—at St. Paul Lutheran Parish Hall

Lion James contacted the coordinators of Oz Fest. It will cost \$197 for a spot and the games must be free. Lion Jim suggested we not participate in the festival since we cannot get people to work the events already and it is not our community. The Club agreed to not participate.

Lion James then brought up Pork Fest. The small tent needs to be found. It was last rumored to be in Lion Suzzee's garage. There are 60 cases of soda left from the fair. There are 34 cases at Paul Kuehl's and the rest is at Tysen's.

A general discussion about the fair was held. We're signed up for next year. After some discussion, the Club decided to continue to use of three shifts at the fair. Members who said they were going to participate, but failed to help this year, need to step up and fill more shifts.

Charles Horn picked up his scholarship check.

We received thank you notes from the 4H Club and Bruce Moser.

Lion Bruce won \$6 at 50/50.

There being no further business, a motion to adjourn was made by Lion Dennis and seconded by Lion Jack. The meeting adjourned at 8:34 PM.
